At Hiatus House we provide a safe environment for women and their families to heal and strengthen, in support of them living empowered lives free of abuse.





What we do

Since its founding in 1976 Hiatus House is committed to assisting women and their children who have experienced gender based violence, intimate partner violence, Domestic Violence and/or Human Trafficking.

We help women and families who are experiencing violence through telephone crisis support, emergency shelter, school-based services and community services.

We are open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

We are the only shelter in Windsor mandated to support women and families who experience violence. Our services offers help and hope to those impacted by violence.





What is Transitional Housing?

Transitional Housing provides safe affordable living where women can learn to live independently with their children before moving into permanent housing.

Transitional Housing is more than a safe place to stay. It offers women and children access to a variety of wrap around services that will help to lead better lives. These services are supported by trained professionals who provide supports and linkages to services throughout the community.

The Need for Transitional Housing

Hiatus House gets an average of 320 crisis calls monthly. Often women in the shelter are discharged to homelessness as a result of the continuing need for emergency space in the existing shelter.

In order to support women leaving abusive situations, access to safe, affordable housing is essential.

Transitional Housing housing will help support these families through a more comprehensive continuum of service delivery leading to greater success and stability.




